I. GENERAL PROVISIONS

This regulation determines the procedure for organizing and holding the International Competition of Performers on Academic Folk Instruments (hereinafter - the competition), which will take place in the Dnipro Academy of Music in two rounds.

I round is a selection, auditions at the educational institutions represented by participants.

II round is held face-to-face (concert performance) and remotely (via video recordings). The competition participants may choose only one of the proposed forms of participation.

- 2. The following are invited to participate in the competition:
 - students of senior classes of primary specialized art educational institutions,
 - students of institutions of vocational pre-higher education,
 - students of higher education institutions.

Participants of the competition of the performers on folk instruments can be the citizens of Ukraine and foreign persons.

- 3. The competition is held with the aim of popularizing and supporting the development of national academic folk-instrumental art in the context of expanding international cultural ties.
- 4. The tasks of the competition include:
 - identification and support of talented children and youth;
 - preservation and development of the best traditions of performing and musical-pedagogical practice of the representatives of academic folk-instrumental art;
 - increasing the level of professional skills of the performers;
 - popularization of the musical art of Ukraine.
- 5. Founders of the competition:
 - International festival of musical art "Music without borders"
 - Communal institution of higher education "Dnipro Academy of Music" of Dnipropetrovsk Regional Council
 - National All-Ukrainian Music Union

II. PROCEDURE

The competition is held within the framework of the Forum of Performers on Folk Instruments at the International Festival of Musical Art "Music without limits", the program of which includes:

- competition opening ceremony;
- scientific and methodological conference;
- registration and drawing of participants who chose the face-to-face form;
- reviewing of video materials and competitive auditions;
- concerts and master classes of the jury members;
- solemn award ceremony;
- final concert of the winners.



III. JURY

- 1. In order to review the video recordings and listen to the competition performances, evaluate the competition participants objectively and determine its winners, the organizing committee shall create a jury, which includes outstanding figures of the musical art of Ukraine and other countries.
- 2. The personal composition of the jury shall be approved by the head of the organizing committee.
- 3. The number of the jury members (in each nomination) may be from three to seven people.
- 4. The jury shall consist of the chairman, members of the jury and the responsible secretary.
- 5. The members of the jury are obliged to observe the rules of secret voting and not to disclose the results of evaluation of the performances of competition participants, as well as the names of winners until the award ceremony. The members of the jury have no right to discuss the performances of competition participants before voting and to publish the results before the official announcement.
- 6. Special diplomas of the competition laureates will be awarded to performers/teams who, together with a high level of performance skills, demonstrate an innovative and creative approach (to stage solutions, repertoire, playing techniques, instrumental composition of the team, etc.).

IV. NOMINATIONS AND AGE CATEGORIES

The competition is held in nominations:

- Accordion, bayan
- Classical guitar
- Instrumental bandura
- Vocal bandura

- Domra, kobza, mandolin
- Cymbals, sopilka
- Ensembles
- Orchestras, bandurist capellas
- Solo with orchestra (provided only in face-to-face form)

I category – junior students of specialized art educational institutions;

II category – students of senior classes of specialized art educational institutions;

III category - students of 1-2 courses of vocational pre-higher education institutions;

IV category - students of 3-4 courses of vocational pre-higher education institutions;

<u>V category</u> - students of higher education institutions.

The number of team participants

(junior students of senior classes of specialized art educational institutions, students of vocational pre-higher and of higher education institutions)

Small ensembles: up to 5 people inclusive, excluding illustrators;

Large ensembles: up to 14 people inclusive, the number of illustrators should not exceed **20%** of the total number of team members;

Orchestras, bandurist capellas: from 15 people, the number of illustrators should not exceed **30%** of the total number of band members.

VI. REQUIREMENTS TO VIDEO MATERIALS

(remote form)

- video must be given in the device horizontal position in compliance with all program requirements of the competition with the extension of 1080p. (HD);
- record must provide the clear and full vision of: the instrument, face and hands of a participant;
- stopping the video camera during a performance is not allowed (recording should be from the beginning to the end of the entire program);
- video performance must begin with a participant's introduction (name and surname) and notice that this video is recorded for the "DniProFolk" International Competition;
- performances not recorded in full shall not be allowed to participate.

VII. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS

All expenses related to participation in the competition (travel, accommodation, meals of the competitors and their accompanying persons) are paid at the participants' own expense.

The entrance fee for participation in the competition is paid by transferring funds to a bank account. The details will be sent after the application registration.
